Description

A rare example of an early ship's wheel of large size and substantial proportions in untouched original condition. The wheel is made from teak - the preferred timber for nautical fittings - and has finely-moulded edges and stout detailed turned spindles terminating in handles. There is a wonderful colour and surface. The brass fittings on the hub and around the rim have aged to a verdigris patination through exposure to the atmosphere. It may benefit from a polish for display purposes, according to taste. Circa 1850 (A small wooden bracket has been added to one side for hanging - see pic 2) Width: 48 ins; 122 cms.
