Arched side sound brass fretwork with silk backing. Ebonised banding to the case front with a diamond. A twin fusee, 5-pillar mechanism striking the hours on a bell. A border engraved backplate, side case mounts and pendulum. Brass bun feet. A convex painted dial with blued steel hands signed 'PAIN, ASH' with a cast brass bezel surround and convex glass. Circa 1830. Mark Pain of Ash is recorded in 'Loomes' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' book as working from 1826-1847.
