Inlaid with an image of St George slaying the dragon in kingwood, walnut and satinwood this is a most interesting, unusual and decorative table. In addition to being the patron saint of England, St George is the patron saint of, and venerated in, Greece, Venice, Genoa and Portugal. This strengthens our opinion that this table originates from Continental Europe and particularly Italy. The inlaid top has canted corners and is supported by a decorated turned column and stands on a quatrefoil base. The table stands well. There are minor signs of age and some historic restoration to the pedestal and top, these are compatible with age.
