Both the silver plated knives and forks are beautifully decorated and each marked by the famous silversmith, Martin Hall. Martin Hall & Co was one of the best known British manufacturers and participated to many international exhibitions including the Crystal Palace 1851 Great Exhibition. Each piece is also lucky enough to have a design registration lozenge mark which allows us to date the design to 12th December 1860. The case has a beautiful label for the retailer, William C Shaw of Glasgow; well known as a clock and watch maker and was also a silversmith. A truly fine set in excellent condition.
