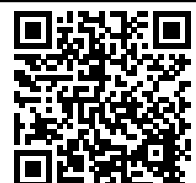
This attractive sofreh was used for kneading the dough to make the bread - 'lavash' in Persian - thus the name bread sofreh as opposed to the more rectangular dining sofreh. This bread sofreh was made by Afshar nomads in Kerman Province, southern Persia during the early part of the twentieth century and is in excellent, complete condition. These sofrehs had a very individual look, which was all to do with the weaver's artistic expression. Size: 97cm x 99cm (3' 2" x 3' 3").
