George III pre 1800 - As the Dial is engraved Simon Levin and he Retired in 1799 when the firm became Simon Levin & Son. The 8 Day Timepiece has been checked, oiled and Tested to be in Good Antique Working Condition. Keeps good time, though due to wear there is a little variation between the first half of the hour and the 2nd. Attractive Flame Mahogany Case with working key and lock. 77.75in or 197.5cm.
