Early Georgian Oak Country Dresser with plate rack. An amazing example of a moderately sized very early dresser. We bring to you this excellent rare example of an original early Georgian George III (circa 1760-1810) solid Oak country farmhouse dresser base. The dresser comes complete with an original plate rack of a very similar period. The plate rack is original and Georgian, however, is not original to this particular dresser. At some point, these 2 items have been married together but suit and fit perfectly. The base features a 2 plank top with a simple moulded edge above 2 deep drawers with nailed plank construction as with all early furniture, before the refinement of the dovetail joint. The drawers are complete with solid lightly polished brass Georgian handles with escutcheon plates. The drawers are supported on a fine pierced fret-worked cross rail which is mimicked on the side panels of the dresser that all stand on Queen Anne hoof legs.
