The What Not has 3 solid rosewood serpentine fronted display shelves, each of which feature no joins to the tops meaning they were constructed from 3 solid planks of rosewood, which is very rare to see. The 3 tiers are supported by finely turned typical Georgian style rosewood upright pillars and finishes to 4 turned rosewood legs standing on its original solid polished brass cup castors. The display stand is constructed with wooden screw threads meaning there is no movement or play in the What Not and the tops are flat with no bowing or twisting.
