Description

A set of three unusual English solid sterling silver and glass bottles. They are all hallmarked for Birmingham 1936 with the maker's marks being WJM&Co for W J Myatt & Co. They have been interestingly designed having silver engine turned lids with cork lining and brown glass bases - possibly for pills or medicine. The silver is free from splits repairs and dings. The glass is free from cracks chips and repairs. They measure approx. 2.25 inches (6cms) tall by 1 inch (2.3cms) across the bases and have a combined weight of 94 grams. A very unusual set.
