A stunning Victorian stationery box made by the creme de la creme of London luxury retailers, Asprey & Co. The inside of the lid is beautifully lined in black leather with a gold embossed Royal Warrant: "Asprey London / 188 Bond Street & 22 Albermarle St. / By Appointment to H.R.H. The Prince of Wales". The box is made from stunning Satinwood with a sloped front inlaid with a central tablet of Mother of Pearl complimenting the Nacre shell escutcheon (alas, no key). The interior edges are finished in exotic Coromandel wood. There are four dividers covered in an aqua coloured marble paper and the front section has a Satinwood lidded compartment topped with a turned Ivory knob. The wonderful thing about this box is it's size (unlike many other period examples) being large enough to accommodate modern day (larger stationery).
