Description

A beautiful English Victorian freestanding occasional table attributed to Holland & Sons with feather banded tulipwood and coromandel wood background inlaid with fine scroll leaf and floral marquetry design. The cabriole legs have excellent quality floral bronze gilt mounts terminating to foliate design feet with shell design to the table edge. The table top lifts up to reveal a storage compartment which features a decorative birds eye maple and rosewood veneered top which can be locked. Holland & Sons was established in 1843 and became one of the largest and most successful cabinet making firms in the Victorian era creating beautiful pieces of furniture. They were granted the Royal Warrant of Appointment and began furnishing and designing for many of the royal households. Height - 28 ½ inches Width - 23 ½ inches Depth - 16 inches
