An unusual Victorian solid silver vesta case with an inner case to hold matches which swings open and neatly fits back in. The outer case is plain silver and there is a striker to the base. At the top there is a large fastening loop for attachment so it could be added to a pocket watch chain. Hallmarks for the London Assay Office are clearly visible with a date mark for 1884 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. The maker's mark for the esteemed and very collectable maker is also visible: Thomas Johnson II. A very collectable and unusual silver Vesta Case by a eminent maker! Condition: In great antique condition - opens and closes well. Some very fine scratching. Hallmarks and Maker's Marks: Thomas Johnson II London 1884.
