Beautiful Graining and Patina to this Good Quality Mahogany Case (91in or 131.5cm high) with Charming Painted Dial Depicting Britannia with Gilt Decoration Seconds Dial and Date Chapter. Though Baille lists Richard Honeybone as circa 1690-1814, Brian Loomes suggests a Richard (I) Honeybone b1775, c1795-d1834 and this would seem more likely. There was also a Richard (II) born 1837 and probably the son of George Honeybone, Richard's brother. The 8 Day movement has been Checked, Oiled and Tested to be in Good and Full Antique Working Condition, Stiking the number of Hours on the O'clock. Please Note: the Dial has two sets of winding holes (though one set is blanked off) also the Plates of the Movement has additional Holes Drilled. Whether Honeybone's customer wanted to economise and Honeybone used part he had lying around or this has been done later in life is unknown but adds intrigue and interest.
