Description

Early C20th Queen Anne revival style walnut armchair with a decorative painted splat back. A beautifully constructed copy of a rare walnut framed armchair of the early C18th Queen Anne period. The traditional balloon-shaped seat with a drop-in upholstered cushion, raised on boldly shaped cabriole fore-legs onto pad feet. The rear cabriole shaped legs with a stylish angled rake, the arms of shaped and swept 'shepherds crook' design. The shaped back splat with an applied cross-grain moulded surround, enclosing a skilfully executed hand-painted panel depicting a classical campana-shaped vase with a vibrantly coloured arrangement of flowers. The oil painting with an 'apple-green' background. The top rail of shaped outline. The reverse of the central back-splat of the armchair, painted with a corresponding handpainted panel of vase and flower decoration. In excellent original condition with a good mellow period-style patina and colour. The painted panels with an aged surface imitating period style paintwork. H 39" W 24" D 20" England c.1920
