A very sturdy reproduction of a Jacobean Oak Dining Table, possibly Victorian or edwardian. It has a good carved cup and cover legs and base with cross stretchers and carved frieze. The top has been stained to restore the dark oak colour but still looks good, there is some evidence of some old worm holes in the top but this has long since disappeared. Dimensions are 35 inches wide 102 inches when fully drawn out and 65 inches when not extended and 30 inches tall with plenty of leg room. It would seat 10/12 people comfortably.
