Description

A superb example of an early 18th Century solid Sterling Silver sugar caster by renowned maker Thomas Bamford. It is an excellent quality piece with a bulbous body, round foot and pierced top with finial. It is made from very good gauge silver and is incredibly heavy for its size, weighing approximately 355g. It is clearly hallmarked on the base for London although the maker and date mark are obscured on the base. On the neck the maker's mark T.B for Thomas Bamford is clearly visible but I cannot make out a year. Thomas Bamford was active during the 1720s and 1730s. It is in excellent condition for its age and has been gently cleaned and polished. There are some faint surface marks and a few minor marks but no major damages or anything detrimental and it displays beautifully.
