It is a good quality piece, weighing approximately 105g. It is clearly hallmarked for London, 1810 and the maker Peter & William Bateman. The maker's mark is slightly rubbed but still distinguishable. It is in good condition for its age. There are some faint surface marks, minor dinks and dents and possibly some areas of old solder in the bottom (see photo) but nothing detrimental and it displays beautifully. It has been gently cleaned and polished is ready for use. The best description comes from the photos so please look at them all carefully and if you have any questions please ask.
