Garrard (founded in 1735), still producing fine silverware and jewellery today, throughout history has been serving and producing exceptional pieces of silver and jewellery for the British Royal Family. The firm was appointed Crown Jeweller by Queen Victoria in 1843 which may come as no surprise upon examining the exceptional quality, craftsmanship and designs of their silverware/jewellery. The pair of cups are matched with a pointed finial lid which sits gently on top. The cups are in the form of larger trophy-style cups, with twin handles and a widened pedestal foot. Both cups are in very good condition with a rich gold tone (silver-gilt) that glistened magnificently under sunlight. The cups and lids are fully hallmarked with English marks.
