This charming namakdan (salt-bag) was made by Kordi nomads in the Quchan area of north-eastern Persia around 1900-1920. The bag is woven in soumak technique on the face incorporating a stunning light-blue, with the back in typical narrow bands of colour in plain-weave technique. The bag is in very good condition with original braided selvages and the remains of tassels in the lower left and right corners. Size: 45cm x 33cm (1' 6" x 1' 1").
