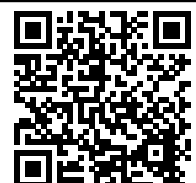
An extremely rare early Victorian miniature silver vesta. This wonderful diminutive example has a large attaching ring for a fob chain or chatelaine. The body is lightly gilded and features acanthus engraved design to three of the sides and beautiful engine turning to the front and back. There is a round vacant cartouche and a striker to the reverse. The lid opens via a thumb-grip and the interior is fully hallmarked and richly gilded. This petite example is very unusual and a choice collector's piece. Dimensions below.
