" From the estate of the late Reverend Anthony Derwent Coleridge (1916-68), by descent from his grandfather, the scholar Ernest Hartley Coleridge (1846-1920), grandson of the iconic English poet Samuel Taylor Coleridge (1772-1834). The purchaser of this desk also acquires pp151-154 of the poet's Notes upon The Friend , copied by Ernest Coleridge directly from Hugh Rose's own first edition copy of The Friend. Rose was a close friend and collaborator of Samuel's. These hand written pages were found crumpled behind the secretaire drawer ."
