Description

The English Arts & Crafts movement (c. 1880-1910) championed hand made pieces with an emphasis on craftsmanship and the aesthetics of design to create beauty rather than intrinsically valuable materials such as diamonds. Natural baroque pearls, silver and uncut stones were considered preferable to precious gemstones and peacock colours and motifs were especially popular. This beautiful and collectable antique Arts and Crafts bracelet is formed of six tumbled pieces of natural turquoise connected with a chain of twisted solid gold links. The links are a lovely soft rosy gold which tests as 9-10ct. The ingeniously shaped bracelet clasp is marked PAT.2591, a patent number found on items originating from Liberty & Co, the important London department store which was instrumental in popularising high-quality Arts and Crafts jewellery, furniture and accessories.
