Description

This is without doubt one of our all time favourite Art Deco comports. Originating from Czech republic and made by Karl Palda this comport packs two punches, not only visually with it's very distinctive green / yellow colouring and jet black enamel accents/design but the pure size of it which stands 23 cm high and 25cm in diameter. The glass is extremely thick and therefore the comport itself is very heavy. The shape is extremely unusual, the column which supports the top and base is a female nude mermaid type figure. The most common colour of uranium glass is pale yellowish-green, which in the 1930s led to the nickname "Vaseline glass" based on a perceived resemblance to the appearance (which was a yellow-green colour) of Vaseline brand petroleum jelly as formulated and commercially sold at that time.
