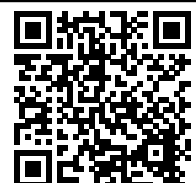
A wonderful Victorian preserve jar, as usable today as 150 years ago. Made by the famous silversmith, Martin Hall & Co. the frame is marked with the makers initials M.H. & Co. together with EPNS for Electro Plated Nickel Silver. This mark dates the piece to around 1860. Martin Hall & Co was one of the best known British manufacturers and participated in many international exhibitions including the Crystal Palace 1851 Great Exhibition. The frame has a pierced or reticulated border to both top and bottom with cut-out Ivy leaves, the lid having a complimentary Ivy leaf engraving. The glass remains in undamaged condition, and the entire piece in excellent condition. 4 1/2" in diameter foot to foot and standing 6 1/4" tall to top of swing handle.
