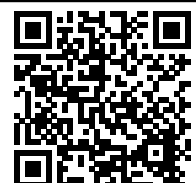

There are three fitted drawers each with Georgian design brass handles and mahogany cross banding. The oak low boy has a decorative shaped apron and is raised on four cabriole legs. A particularly good example with excellent colour throughout. Item Ref; M-2922 . DIMENSIONS: Height – 72cm / Width – 102cm / Depth – 55cm . CONDITION REPORT: In good antique condition throughout with some signs of age. There is surface wear in places including age related marks and staining to the top (pictured). The oak low boy remains structurally solid and sound with the drawers running well. There are some losses to the mahogany cross banding. Overall a particularly good example of an antique oak low boy side table.
