Highly collectable because of its rarity, this early Karachopf was woven in the Caucasian mountains by members of the Kazak people. It is an exceptional example of the very best tribal art from the area, with a lovely shade of pink red, a naive design of simple medallions floating on the serene background and also exceptionally high pile, polished to a beautiful, sparkling patina through the passing of decades. A truly extraordinary rug with so many pleasing details- look how the borders are resolved in the corners, there is a lot more to this rug than at first meets the eye. Some minor repiling to two corners and the sides new overbound.
