Description

1920s Cyma full hunter pocket watch. The watch has a nicely jewelled Swiss stem-winding movement, identified as a Cyma calibre 918, which is working nicely. The movement is signed with the Cyma calibre 918 and 17 jewels, 4 adjustments, Swiss made. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. Cyma was founded by two brothers, Joseph and Theodore Schwob, in 1862. In 1892 they decided to go into partnership with Frédéric Henri Sandoz, owner of Henri Sandoz et Cie. The Cyma name was officially registered in 1903. Sandoz used the most modern of manufacturing processes and produced very high quality time-pieces, trademarked as Tavannes, Cyma and Cyma Tavannes. Their excellent reputation for quality meant that by 1910, Tavannes / Cyma were one of the largest Swiss watch manufacturers in existence. State, or Stayte, was one of the brand names used by the company. The watch measures 50.2mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the loop. The case is gold filled and was made by the Illinois Watch Case Company. The case has engine turned detail to the front and back with a vacant cartouche to the front. The case is in nice condition with only two small "dings" to the b...
