Description

Bread 'sofrehs' like this one are rare. The bread sofreh was a weaving for kneading the dough on before baking the bread on a hot plate over a fire. This sofreh was made by Taimani tribes, part of the Chahar Aimaq confederation, in the Charchagan area of Ghor Province in west-central Afghanistan circa 1900. The sofreh is in excellent overall condition with no repairs whatsoever. Size: 1.22m (4') square.
