He started a successful career as a painter then studied sculpture under the renowned Mathurin Moreau at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts in Paris and with Emile Thomas. In 1882 he made his debut at the Paris Salons winning various awards. His work was part of the sculpture event in the Art competition at the 1924 summer olympics. His works are always of very quality with great attention to detail.
