A rare 19th Century lithyalin glass scent bottle with silver hinged lid. The lid has a lip to assist opening and inside is the original lithyalin glass peg stopper. The body is of flattened circular form, with bevelled cutting to the edges and is very tactile. Lithyalin glass is found in a variety of colours, including this in variations of red. It was created in Bohemia by Friedrich Egermann (1777-1864) and its name derives from the Greek 'lithos' meaning stone. A superb and sought after collector's item. Dimensions below.
