This antique Ushak carpet has been woven with a symmetrical pillar design which we can see in the main field of the design. The design is very elegant and subtle along with the delightful muted tones we would expect to see from an Anatolian carpet from this region woven around 1890-1900. The sludgy greens, pale greens, muted oranges on the ivory main background make for a beautiful combination of colours. This would sit happily in a drawing room to furnish around due to the gentle colours and delicate design. Condition wise it is very good indeed, Ushak carpets are known for their loose construction using soft wool and they are not fine carpets like classical Persian examples. The pile of the carpet is very high nearly all over with minimal wear and a couple of old areas of restoration. A very decorative attractive carpet, which as you can see from the professional photograph has great appeal and beauty.
