Description

An unusual double serpentine fronted oak Franco Flemish commode on claw and bun feet dating to the early 18th Century. Franco - Flemish region, circa 1720. The moulded top above three long drawers each with conforming bowed / bombé fronts with the original brass handles and twin escutcheons, flanked by moulded quadrant corner terminals with carved surmounts, the sides with a shaped and fielded panels and the whole raised on wonderfully carved claw and bun front feet. This superb serpentine fronted commode was purchased from a large chateau. A rare example being of solid oak with its distinctive shaped drawer fronts and pronounced mouldings with an excellent colour and patina.
