Description

1930s Cyma pocket watch and chain for J W Benson. The watch has a Swiss 15-jewel stem-winding movement, identified as a Cyma, which is working nicely. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover which has a little scratching and an indentation. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is the gold plated Star model from the English watch case maker Aaron Dennison. There is a small bruise to the side of the watch and a slight indentation to the back but overall the condition is good. The glass lens has a couple of small marks but nothing too serious. The dial is signed with the retailer's name, J W Benson. J W Benson originated in 1847, founded by James William Benson and Samuel Suckley Benson. They were regarded as one of Victorian London's most prestigious retail jewellers and they also manufactured their own watch movements. The company flourished and proudly boasted an elite client base made up of both British and European royalty and a selection of well heeled industrialists and business figures including the King of Siam, the King of Portugal, the King of Denmark, the Emperor of Japan, the Tsar of Russia and...
