A similar FIGURE is illustrated in A & N Harding's Victorian Staffordshire Figures Volume 1 Page 384 Figure 1498. These Figures are decorated in very attractive colours and, presumably, by the same Staffordshire Decorator. I'd like to think they have been together since the day they were made.
