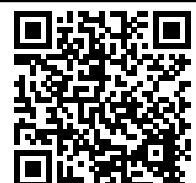
A rare late 18th Century silver 'Harvey Sauce' condiment Label. This wonderful piece is rectangular in shape, with 'clipped' corners and a reeded border. The word 'Harvey' is engraved to the centre. The label is supported on a belcher chain and the title is in 'pricked' initials. Harvey sauce is a bottled relish introduced in the late 18th century, and becoming very popular in the mid-nineteenth (a rival to Worcestershire sauce), and is still available today. Ingredients include anchovies, walnut pickle, soy sauce and shallots, cayenne, garlic and vinegar. An excellent, rare and unusual piece of Georgian 18th Century silver. Dimensions below.
