Double Series opaque twist stem consisting of a pair of spiral tapes outside a 12-ply spiral band. Conical foot with a snapped pontil. **Jacobite sympathy example.** **Date & Origin** England, c1760. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. **Dimensions** Height: 15cm Bowl Diameter: 4.7cm Foot Diameter: 6.2cm. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time that the English clockmaker, John Harrison, produced the first successful marine chronometer "The No. 1 sea watch".

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
