The silver bar to the top is signed by the well renowned manufacturer "Betjemman's" and is marked "Betjemman's Patent, London" and the other side engraved "The Tantalus"; Betjemman was the finest maker of Tantalus. To add to the pedigree of this example, the Coromandel case is mounted by the famous London retailer, "Mappin & Webb Ltd. 2 Queen Victoria St. EC". The lock comes with a key and once unlocked, the barrel can be pressed down to release the bar enabling the decanters to be removed. Each of the bottles is beautifully hand cut. A special example in excellent condition measuring 14 1/2" x 5 3/4" x 11 3/4" tall to top of handle. Each decanter measures 3 1/4" square x 8 1/4" tall.
