The flat lid opens on blacksmith made strap hinges to a plain interior with boarded floor. It is in good original condition and has developed a beautiful rich patina. It has avoided ever being overcarved and is a very pretty well balanced example. There are signs of age and use and signs of historic worm in the back panels which has all been treated as a precaution and hasn't affected the piece structurally or aesthetically.
