Description

Pair of early C19th Dutch 'japanned' pewter chestnut urns of neo-classical design. Of good large scale, the ovoid tapering bodies with scarlet red ground and gilt decoration depicting country landscape scenes, the removable covers with acorn style finials. The sides fitted with well-modelled decorative lions-mask ring handles. In excellent original condition with only minor loss of decoration and historic minor dents and mis-shaping to the covers commensurate with age, use and purpose. *urns of this type were used to carry hot chestnuts from the fireplace to the table, their fashionable neoclassical design adding to the decorative scheme of the dining room when not in use.
