Description

A superb small Georgian oak longcase clock c1750 ~~ Fully restored and serviced ~~ This is a fabulous small longcase clock made by Samuel Austin of Romsey Hampshire dated to around 1750. The case has been fully restored and is made of quarter sawn english oak with beautiful figuring which has mellowed over the centuries into a warm colour, the grain and patina is just superb. The case is decorated with with ebony and satinwood stringing with mahogany crosbanding, this theme is carried on through the trunk, door and base which also has fine mahogany crossbanding. The case is enhanced with reeded ebonised corners and ebonised pillars to the hood. It also has a fully working lock and key. The hood still retains its original glass which has that slight rippling effect that you only see in very old glass. The clock dial is of polished solid brass with decorative corner spandrels and silvered chapter ring, of course it is fully marked Samuel Austin Rumsey the old spelling for Romsey. It has a superb 8 day movement with working seconds and date indication. The clock strikes the hours on a large bell and is keeping good time. The clock is in full working order and h...
