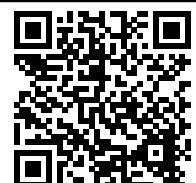
A very fine and original brass bound mahogany marine chronometer by the esteemed maker Robert Roskell of Liverpool, dating to the late 1830's, numbered 774/48061. The brass bound three tier mahogany case is in beautiful original condition with excellent colour and patination. "Liverpool flush" handles to the sides, brass escutcheons and plaque to the front, the top lid having shaped brass corners and central brass plaque. The original hinges and locks, with the original glazing to the upper tier. The fully serviced and rated freesprung 8 day movement with diamond endstone to a blued steel helical hairspring, to a cut bi-metallic balance with trapezoidal timing weights and Earnshaw type spring detent escapement with maintaining power and chain fusee. Mounted in a polished brass gimballed bowl with rotating winding aperture cover and glazed brass bezel. The signed and numbered silvered Roman and Arabic dial with running seconds and 7 day state of winding subsidiaries, with blued steel hands. Signed Robert Roskell Liverpool 774/48061 (Of the fractional numbers, the first is the individual one and the second the total quantity of all products.) The original ratcheted t...
