Description

Handsome William IV mahogany breakfast dining table c.1835. Rectangular top made of two solid mahogany boards arranged so the grain makes a symmetrical pattern. With rounded corners over a slim crossbanded veneered apron. Raised on a splendid broad turned column pedestal with carved acanthus detail and a segmented collar at the base. On a shaped plinth, also with a crossbanded edge, and turned bun feet with brass castors recessed below. Top can be tipped to vertical when not in use, locking into place with the original catch. Some old wear to the top which has faded to an attractive mellow colour over time, minor wear and repairs to the crossbanding. Generally very good original condition, solid and sturdy, cleaned and waxed in our workshops. Dimensions: Width 45½", Height 29", Length 57½".
