A 17th century Yorkshire Wainscot chair from Leeds, with a double panel top of horizontal tulips above four large diamond leaves, a central quatrefoil, set against a cross hatched backdrop. The uprights are inlaid with triangular pieces of Holly and oak. A similar chair is featured in the Regional Furniture magazine (figure 2); and is housed at Townley Hall in Burnley. The chair is a wonderful rich colour with a great patina and unfortunately the images don't do it justice!
