Edwardian burr walnut and parquetry Sutherland table of rare form; the top inlaid with five panels of boxwood scrollwork of 18th century character. The frame with slender turned spindles with a pendant bell motif. Good colour and patination. Late 19th early 20th century. Flaps up 30" (76cm wide [flaps down 9 3/4" (22cm)], 20" (51cm) deep and 24 1/4" (61.5cm) high. John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940.
