Early C19th French Charles X period mahogany console table of impressive proportions. Powerful Empire-style mahogany console or pier table with boldly carved forelegs with classical honeysuckle and acanthus detailed carving onto compressed carved lions' paw feet. Fitted a full-length frieze drawer with a recessed platform base below, the back upright supports of flat pilaster form. Superb quality of figured mahogany throughout, the drawer having 'book matched' flame veneers, the platform with figured 'plum-pudding' mahogany. The original carrara marble top with a reeded edge and gently D-shaped ends. In excellent original condition with a rich colour and patina. The carrara marble top with only minor historic marks and stains. A highly decorative and practical table for a hallway or dining room, for use as a console, pier or serving table or for perhaps displaying a collection of classical bronzes or objects.
