## Description

A beautifully English solid sterling silver quaich cup. It is hallmarked for London 1945 with the makers marks being W&W for Wakely & Wheeler. It has been superbly made with a Celtic design and the bowl has been engraved with what I think is the insignia of the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry insignia and '43rd WR.HG.BN' (West Riding Home Guard Battalion?). It is in superb condition, having no dings splits or repairs. It measures approx. 5.75 inches (14cms) across including the handles and 3.5 inches (9cms) excluding them by almost 1 inch (2.3cms) tall and weighs 84 grams. A stunning very interesting WWII era example.
