Mr. Pickwick stands before a hollow tree trunk where you can rest your cane. He measures an impressive 26 inches (66 cm) in height, is well-detailed and strikes a very attractive pose. The Stick Stand is in overall good condition with no restoration. He is missing his little finger on one hand, has a couple of minor chips and some paint loss. In life, as in the novel, Mr. Pickwick is versatile.
