Description

A pair of large scale oil paintings by Robert Cleminson (1864-1903) depicting gun dogs at rest one within a mountainous back drop and one within a woodland setting. Housed in later double swept carved gilt wood frames, signed by the artist. Dimensions: pictures 35" wide x 17" high, Frames 44" wide x 38" high. Robert Cleminson (1864 - 1903) Cleminson was a painter in oils of landscapes, Highland game and sporting dog paintings and it is his animal and dog paintings for which he is best known. He no doubt found a ready market for his paintings which are as popular today as they were during his lifetime. He exhibited 10 works at the British Institution which was established as a rival to the Royal Academy, at Boydell's Shakespeare Gallery in Pall Mall, London. He exhibited further works at the Society of British Artists, Suffolk Street, London.

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
