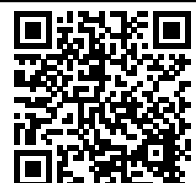

Fitted with the original blue glass liner and sold with a gorgeous solid silver Albany pattern condiment spoon with gilt shell bow. The spoon dated London 1886. Hallmarks: W.C for William Comyns.
