Additionally, the widened feet support the boat superbly and allow for the aesthetic curves, designs and shapes to reveal themselves under many tones of reflective highlights and shadows. The pair make a highly desirable piece of Georgian silverware whether for collection or for practical use as tableware - ideal for holding any sauces of your choice for a luxurious and indulging meal. In addition to other silverware, the pair makes for an excellent display of the fine Georgian craftsmanship.
